

## How to use our FAB Suisse E-Banking Apps

### FIRST TIME SET-UP

#### ACTIVATION OF MOBILE BANKING

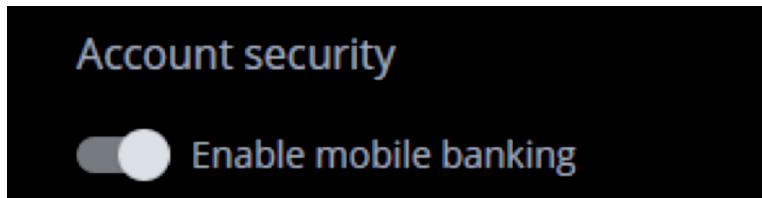
Before you can use the e-banking apps for the first time, you must enable the use of mobile banking via the full web version (accessed via [www.fabsuisse.ch](http://www.fabsuisse.ch) or [www.fabebanking.ch](http://www.fabebanking.ch)).

After logging in, please go to the setting icon in the top-right of the screen.



Then select “Account & Profile” and then click on the “General” button.”

Then please set the “Enable mobile banking” button to the right (i.e. in the picture below mobile banking has been enabled).



#### DOWNLOADING OF THE APP

In the App Store or Google Store, please search for “FAB Suisse”, and download the app as normal.

#### REGISTER / LOGIN

For the first time of using the app, you will need to register. Please press the “Register” button at the bottom of the page, and then enter your e-banking contract and password, etc. You will then have registered the device. You will need to do this for each new device which is used.

For future use, the Register button is replaced by Login, please push this to Login to the application.

Your contract number and password are the same as used for the web-banking. Your contract number and password are the same as used for the web-banking, you will also receive each time a one-time password (MTAN) via SMS to your mobile phone.

The view in the app will depend on whether you are holding the phone/tablet vertically or horizontally (tablet only). For the most complete view, please hold horizontally.

The User Guide for the web-banking version provides further details on the various functionalities.

#### ADD QUICK LINKS

In the welcome page of the App, you will see an image in the top part of the screen, and the quick links in the bottom part. Before you login you will see the standard default quick links, and after completing login each time you will see your personalized quick links.

To access the main menu, push the icon in the top right, which will then produce the menu. Select “Settings” and then “Quick Links”. You can then select the quick link views you wish to have. When finished, please push the back arrow button at the top left and then “Done”.
